This Award is aimed at Special Schools across Scotland that use art in a range of curricular activities to stimulate and develop talent and learning. Inclusiveness is at the heart of this Award.

Integration and parity of support for our young people with disabilities is the primary aim. The Award encourages students to develop an engaging and creative artwork as part of their learning and therapy, inspired by one of the following themes:

- Moon and the stars
- Mountains and rivers
- Trees and flowers
- Streets and shops
- Below the ocean
- Wonderful patterns

The judges will be looking for evidence of how art is inspiring learning, originality and creativity.

The Award is open to special schools in Scotland. Students should be the equivalent of S1-S6 level. Terms & Conditions are as for the main awards.
