TAKE THE CHALLENGE

Respond to this year's theme PAUSE using the media of film. Be as experimental as you like, as abstract or as figurative as you feel. We are looking for a moving artwork, not a documentary.

Being a teenager in 2020 has not been easy. Your ability to explore the world has been severely curtailed and your life has been put on PAUSE. But life goes on somehow. What is this special 'somehow' that you have been living through?

Using a combination of found footage on your phone and a fresh approach to film to pull it together, create and submit a short digital work.

Medium: Digital – film/still image/video/camera phone footage
music/voice/sound effects may be used

Duration: Between 1 and 3 minutes

1 Second Everyday

RULES OF ENTRY

1. Open to students studying Art and Design in S5-6 in the school session 2020/21.
2. One digital artwork per pupil should be submitted via WeTransfer labelled with pupil's name, school and artwork title.
3. Multiple entries can be submitted together in a zip file.
4. Entries should be submitted along with all other entries for the Schools Art Award.
5. Entry deadline: Friday 12 February.
6. You may enter other work in the Main Awards.
